Four years ago, our family spent the summer in Hungary. We were a part of an English camp outreach called SpeakOut. We were encouraged by the following story of a Hungarian girl whose life was changed through this outreach last summer.

A year ago, Hajni was a freshman at the University of Economics in Budapest. She heard about SpeakOut English Camp through some friends in her dorm, who were involved with Campus Crusade's ministry. She decided to go to SpeakOut even though her English was not that strong.

During SpeakOut, Hajni had many different conversations, with her American tutor, and with the Hungarian Campus Crusade staff. Mara, a staff member, shared the Four Spiritual Laws booklet with Hajni. Later that evening, Hajni made a decision of faith.

Many people had been praying for Hajni throughout the week. During breakfast the next morning, she shared about her decision. Her true joy was a great evidence of the seriousness of her commitment to and understanding of Christ.

The staff in Hungary went through the first follow-up lesson with her before the end of SpeakOut, and she was discipled this past year by the ministry in Budapest.
