In February, we were asked to finalize our plans for our summer assignment with Campus Crusade. At that point, we thought we would be spending the summer in Colorado. We planned to serve on the conference team for Campus Crusade's bi-annual staff conference and summer leadership program.

But God had other plans for us. First, we were challenged to consider staffing a stateside summer mission project. **We felt like it was strategic for us to minister with students this summer.**

During this same time, we discovered that a student from our church was considering a summer mission to Hungary. We started talking about how much fun it would be to go back there.

We have a long history with Hungary. We lived in eastern Hungary for a year, helping to start a new campus ministry. We still have relationships with both Americans and Hungarians who work for Campus Crusade there.

In 1996, we were part of a summer mission project to Hungary. We helped lead an evangelistic conversational English camp. Jeff had his first experience in Hungary in 1990, the summer after the fall of communism in Eastern Europe.

As we began to talk about it, the idea of going back to Hungary seemed more and more attractive. **The summer project is much like the one we participated in nine years ago.** It is in the same location and is the same type of evangelistic camp that we staffed in 1996.

We began to pray and investigate the possibility of going to Hungary this summer. From the beginning, Katy was excited about going and began to pray with us. One day in the car she prayed, **"God, You know what You want us to do this summer. Please tell us."**

We contacted the project director who lives in Hungary. He was very excited that we were considering coming. He felt like our previous experience in Hungary would make us a great asset to the project.

In about two weeks time, God had radically altered our plans for the summer. **We are going to Hungary!** We are really glad that we could actively involve Katy in the process as we prayed and sought God's direction.

The project dates are **June 23 - July 27.** We are planning to spend an extra week in Hungary after the project to visit Debrecen, the city we lived in for a year. We'll also visit some friends that live in the capital of Budapest.

During the course of the project, we will disciple American high school and college students and train them in ministry skills. **We will also be able to share the gospel as we tutor Hungarian students and teach English classes.**

In the next few weeks, we will let you know how **you can play a vital role on our summer mission team** to help reach Hungarians and build into the lives of American high school and college students.
