Each summer, Campus Crusade give students the opportunity to change both their lives and the world by participating in Summer Projects. These 1 to 10 week projects provide a greenhouse environment of personal spiritual growth and ministry training.

This past summer, nearly 2,800 students participated in 140 different summer projects in the U.S. and around the world. As a result, **over 35,000 people heard the gospel message and 2,802 indicated decisions for Christ.**

Jeff participated in his first summer project in San Diego over 16 years ago. It stretched his faith as he shared his faith on the beaches of California and saw God work in his life and the lives of the 50 other students on the project.

It was while in San Diego that Jeff caught a greater vision for the world which led him to go to Hungary the following summer. Summer projects were foundational to both of our decisions to serve full-time with Campus Crusade for Christ.

Last April, Jeff started working with the Summer Projects design team to redesign the website that promotes these summer opportunities.

We wanted to create more visual appealing site that communicates the fun and excitement of the Summer Project environment. We also wanted to highlight the breadth of opportunities that are available. From launching new ministries on campuses in the U.S. and worldwide, to projects with an artistic focus, to projects

focused on athletes and medical professionals, students have many diverse options.
