God at Work in Lives of Latino Students in Texas

• Pray for the 19 students who came to Christ through Destino's ministry at Texas A&M. Pray that they would grow in their new relationship with the Lord and would multiply their lives by sharing Christ with others.

On September 8, Jeff launched a new design of destinomovement.com. We appreciated your prayers for this project. We thought you would be encouraged to hear what God is doing with Destino at Texas A&M.

God is at work among Latinos at Texas A&M. Two weeks ago, the movement passed out Freshman Survival Kits to 300 Latino freshmen and invited them to their weekly meeting. They had 140 students attend their weekly meeting, their largest turn out.

At the meeting, students were split into smaller groups and heard a gospel presentation. One of the leaders, Claudia, saw four girls in her group respond to the gospel. Later in the week she saw two more girls accept Christ with her.

As the week went on the student leaders began following up the Freshman Survival Kit contacts.

Felicia - "I met with one of my contacts, Karina, today for lunch and to my surprise she accepted Christ. I felt like God sent Karina and wanted her to start her walk with Him. Patricia went with me and it was awesome because it was the cycle of spiritual multiplication in action because I accepted Christ with Patricia and then we both saw someone come to Christ together."

Anthony - "I invited my roommate to Destino on Tuesday and at the end of the meeting he

told me how awesome it was. He also told me that he accepted Christ. He kept on thanking me for inviting him and it was just so awesome to know that my roommate accepted Christ and now we can be brothers under God."

In the first two weeks of classes, 19 students have started following Christ. Just 18 months ago we had less than 10 people attending Destino at Texas A&M.


